

PERMASET® Thickener

PERMASET® Thickener may be used to increase the viscosity of **PERMASET®** screen printing inks, typically after dilution with another additive (e.g. **PERMASET® Print Retarder**) or water. The higher viscosity may be required to print through more open mesh (e.g. **PERMAPRINT® Premium** through 34 T/86 tpi mesh).

This product can be used with all ranges of **PERMASET AQUA®** Standard, **PERMASET SUPERCOVER®**, **PERMAPRINT® Premium** and **PERMATONE®** products.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

PERMASET® Thickener should only be added under vigorous stirring. Failure to observe this precaution is likely to result in seeding.

Wear appropriate PPE, e.g. suitable gloves, respirator and goggles, stand upwind from container.

- Generally, a maximum of 10–20 mL of **PERMASET® Thickener** per litre of ink should be sufficient and 5 minutes stirring should be ample.
- Use a bucket or clean mixing vessel that is at least 30% bigger than the volume of ink that you wish to mix. This extra 30% volume (ullage) is required to allow vigorous stirring.
- Shake the bottle of **PERMASET**® **Thickener** for at least one (1) minute before use.
- If there is any sign of skinning or lumps in the thickener, the entire contents should be strained before use.
- Pour the **PERMASET**® **Ink** to be thickened into the mixing vessel.
- Place the mixing vessel under the mixer and ensure that it is securely fastened.
- Start the mixer and increase speed until a vortex forms.
- Pour the **PERMASET® Thickener** slowly and in a thin stream into the vortex close to the spindle. As above, failure to observe this precaution is also likely to result in seeding.
- The level of addition depends on personal preference for ink viscosity.
- After thoroughly stirring, test print the ink. If the ink is still too runny, then repeat the addition, stirring and test printing until the required viscosity has been achieved.
- Check the temperature of the ink while mixing. Stop mixing immediately if the temperature exceeds 35 °C. If further mixing is required, the ink must be cooled down prior to any further agitation. Mix again only after cooling.
- If over thickened, use **PERMASET® Print Retarder** or water to reduce viscosity again.

CAUTION

The improper addition and/or mixing of **PERMASET® Thickener** can result in lumps or seeds in the ink. In some instances, remixing for 10–15 min with a power mixer will be sufficient to recover the ink. In other cases, the ink can be recovered by straining. However, if the seeding is very bad, then the ink will need to be discarded. It cannot be overstated how important it is that **PERMASET® Thickener** is added **carefully** and mixed well, as described above.

STORAGE & HANDLING

Containers should be kept in a cool dark place out of direct sunlight and away from sources of heat. Ensure adequate ventilation during use. Containers should be tightly closed when not in use. Keep out of reach of children.

SHELF LIFE

12 months if stored in a cool, dry place, out of direct sunlight. Once opened, the product should be used within 3 months.

The shelf life of the ink mixture will depend upon storage conditions and housekeeping. Please refer to the **PERMASET®** Product Information Guide on housekeeping.

SAFETY NOTES

Respiratory Protection: If risk of inhalation of fumes exists, wear a combined organic

vapor/particulate respirator complying with AS/NZS 1715/1716.

Hand Protection: Neoprene, polyvinyl chloride (PVC) or nitrile rubber gloves.

FIRST AID MEASURES
